## IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 1-96**

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 4-87 OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATING OF CERTAIN BUSINESSES, CALLINGS, TRADES AND OCCUPATIONS.

WHEREAS, according to Section 7, Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting businesses, business activities and persons engaged in business,

AND WHEREAS, according to Section 8, Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Council may in a by-law provide for a system of licences, permits or approvals,

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to amend the license fees to be paid by any and all businesses operating within the corporate limits of the Village of Barnwell,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule 'A1" attached to and forming part of By-Law No. 4-87 is amended as follows:

	License Fees
For Residents	
Single business, trade, calling or occupation	\$ 25 per year
Home Occupations	\$ 25 per year
Non Residents	
For all or any type of business, trade or occupation	\$ 100 per year \$ 25 per week \$ 10 per day
Hawkers, pedlars	\$ 10 per day
