CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BYLAW 05-18

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW 01-15 BEING THE TRAFFIC BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statures of Alberta, 2000, Council may pass Bylaws for the purposes respecting transport and transportation systems

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 13(1) of the Traffic Safety Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. T-6, Council may make Bylaws for the regulation and control of vehicle, animal and pedestrian traffic within the municipality that are not inconsistent with the Act, and;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts the following amendments to Bylaw 01-15.

- 1. Section N of Bylaw 01-15 shall be renamed 'Miscellaneous Restrictions' and shall include the following additional clauses:
 - 9) No person shall organize, arrange or participate in any parade or special highway event on a highway unless permission for the event has been obtained from the Administrator of the Village of Barnwell and Alberta Transportation in the case of a parade or special event on a highway.
 - 10) Except in emergency braking situations, the use of engine retarder brakes, including a Jake Brake, or similar devices is prohibited within the Village of Barnwell limits.
 - 11) No person shall operate or drive any off-highway vehicle or equipment within the Village of Barnwell except for the purpose of snow removal.
 - 12) Notwithstanding anything elsewhere contained in this bylaw the provisions of clause 11 do not apply to:
 - i. Municipal or other government public works vehicles or equipment; or
 - ii. Equipment used for construction purposes and yard care travelling to and from the site in the shortest route possible.

- 13) All off-highway vehicles used for the purposes of Clause 11 and/or 12 must be equipped with 'Slow Moving Vehicle' signs and use hazard/flashing lights while in operation.
- 2. This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading hereof.

READ a first time this 16 day of Augus + , 2018.

READ a second time this 16 day of Augus + 2018.

READ a third time and finally PASSED this 16 day of August, 2018.
