PIE CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBLE PIES

Any dessert pie, like saskatoon, apple, pecan, or banana cream with either single or double crust. All sweet pies are welcome!



GENERAL RULES

- Contest is open to bakers of all ages!
- Pie must be entered in the name of the person who baked it.
- Baker may enter up to three pies.
- Pies must be made from scratch, including the crust. You may NOT use pre-made store-bought crust or filling.
- Pies must be presented in a 9"- 10" pie plate / pan. Where possible, we request that disposable tins be used.
- Your pie(s) will be NOT be returned to you. After judging, your pies will be sliced and sold by donation to the general public.
- Bakers agree to have their photo or pie photo published without compensation.
- Pies must be dropped off at the Willow Park kitchen between 3PM and 4PM on Saturday, July 16th.
- Each pie should be accompanied by a Pie Contest Form and must include your name, phone number, and list of ingredients.
- Pies will be assigned a random number and judges will not be present where pies are dropped off to ensure anonymity of the bakers.
- Judging of pies will take place after 4:30 PM and winners will be announced at 7PM.

JUDGING OF PIES

- Pies will be judged in the categories of Crust, Filling / Flavour, and Appearance.
- Crust – 40 points
- Filling / Flavour – 40 points
- Appearance – 20 points
- Scoring
 1. Judges will assign numerical values in each category without consultation with each other.
 2. The pie receiving the highest numerical value in each category will win that category.
 3. In the case of a tie, the judges will judge those pies again.
- The winner in each category will receive a prize and the bragging rights for their respective category.
- The judges will also present a prize for Best Overall Pie – the pie receiving the highest total numerical value out of 100 will be the winner. The baker of the Best Overall Pie will receive a distinctive prize and the title of Pie Boss for Barnwell Days 2022!
- The decision of the judges will be final.

REGISTRATION

You can pick up your Pie Contest Forms in the Village office or download it from our website. As long as your pie has a completed Pie Contest Form, is made from scratch, and is dropped off at the right place and time, your pie will be accepted. Good luck bakers!
