**BYLAW NO. 1-06** 

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORDERLY NAMING AND NUMBERING OF ROADS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL

WHEREAS the Council may, pursant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, pass a bylaw for the orderly naming and numbering of roads and for revisions to those name and numbers from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the municipality may prepare a bylaw to name and number roads within its boundaries and provide for its consideration at a public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

- That the orderly naming and numbering of roads within the Village shall be as shown on the map in Schedule A.
- 2. This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading hereof.
