BYLAW NO. 01-12

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL FOR THE 2012 TAXATION YEAR

WHEREAS, the Village of Barnwell has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on May 17, 2012

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Village of Barnwell for 2012 total \$1,166,323; and

WHEREAS, the requisitions are

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Barnwell is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions; and

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Village of Barnwell as shown on the assessment roll is:

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than property taxation is estimated at \$ 780,175; and the balance of \$ 386,148 is to be raised by general municipal property taxation; and

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Barnwell, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

 That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Village of Barnwell:
