CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BYLAW NO. 2-06

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORDERLY NUMBERING OF PARCELS OF LAND AND BUILDINGS PLACED THEREON IN THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL;

WHEREAS the Council may, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, pass a bylaw for the orderly numbering and displaying of numbers on parcels of land and buildings and for revisions to those numbers from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the municipality may prepare a bylaw to assign a number to identify buildings or parcels of land within its boundaries and provide for its consideration at a public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

- That the orderly numbering of parcels of land and buildings within the Village shall be as shown on the map in Schedule A.
- That the orderly numbering of parcels of land and buildings and units and subunits within buildings, shall be as follows:
- (a) Odd numbers shall be assigned to the South and East side of the streets.
- (b) Even numbers shall be assigned to the North and West side of the streets.
- (c) On lots that are 25 feet, or thereabouts, the building numbers assigned shall be calculated to the middle of the lot, with the number increasing incrementally by two (2).
- (d) On lots that are 50 feet, or thereabouts, the building numbers assigned shall be calculated to the middle of the lot, with the number increasing incrementally by four (4).
- (e) On parcels of land or buildings which are situated on cul-de-sacs or other odd shaped parcels the numbers so arrived at shall be styled as near as possible with numbers on the changing from odd to even at the mid-point of the circle or parcel.



- (f) The numbering system shall work on the avenues from Heritage Road West and from Heritage Road East.
- (g) The numbering system shall work on the streets from 1st Avenue West and from 1st Avenue East.
- ω number assigned to their buildings units, or sub-units, as shown on Schedule A, at all times and to their land only when required by administration to do so. All assessed owners of property or buildings are hereby required to display the
- 4 previously assigned and/or displayed numbers from their buildings within 3 months numbering as shown on Schedule A. from the date of the final passing of this bylaw, so as not to confuse the order of the All assessed owners of property or buildings are hereby required to remove any
- 5 When obvious errors are found in existing numbers that are currently in use, and it is advisable to correct the same, administration may require the owner or occupant of the said building to obtain and display the corrected numbers.
- တ Failure to comply with any part of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or in lieu thereof payment of a voluntary fine of \$50.00 per offense.
- This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading hereof.
