IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BYLAW NO. 4-09

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BARNWELL FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the roadways closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Barnwell deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

That portion of lane lying north of Block 2 within Plan 702 JK located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, Township 9, Range 17 West of the 4th Meridian, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
