

**VILLAGE OF BARNWELL
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BYLAW 04-23**

A Bylaw of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel a portion of public roadway to create title in the name of the municipality for subsequent disposal through sale of the land in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended.

WHEREAS the land hereafter described, and as illustrated in attached Schedule 'A' is no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Barnwell deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same; and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Barnwell in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of creating title in the name of the municipality for subsequent disposal through sale of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:




